"We're planting lots of Alyssum seeds today!" said the Omega Twins as they carefully watered the little flower pots.

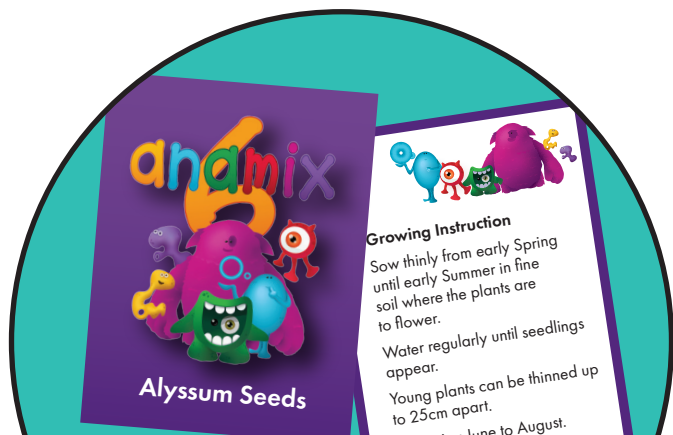
"Butterflies love these flowers too!"

"Our garden is going to look brilliant!"



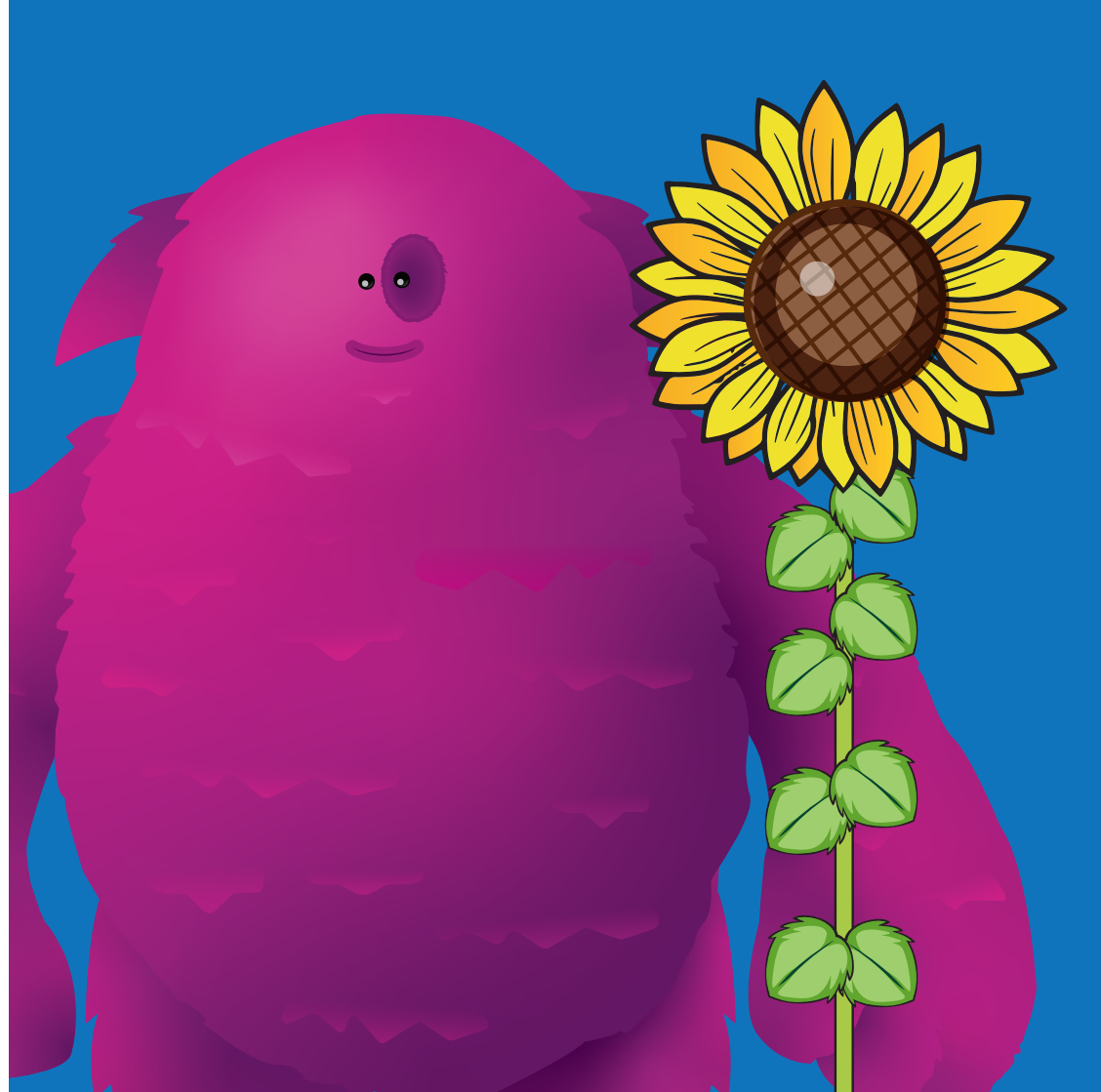
"Think of all the different flowers that will be blooming

said the Omega Twins.

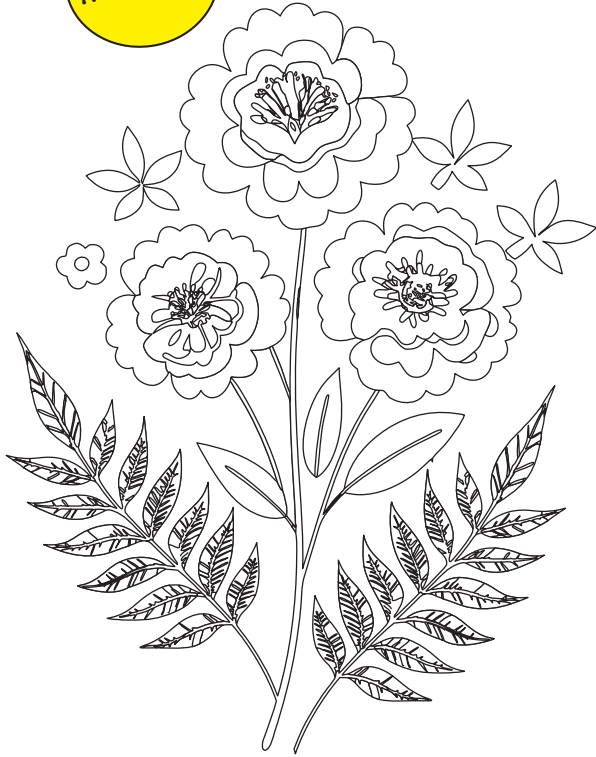
"And loads of colourful Marigolds!" said Brains.



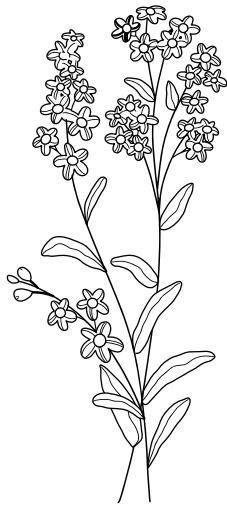
"And Sunflowers that are as tall as I am!" said Bones.
It's going to be a blooming wonderful Summer.



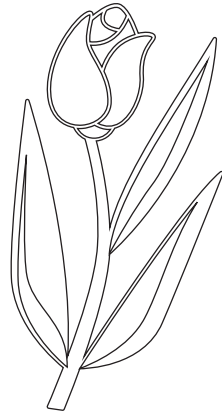

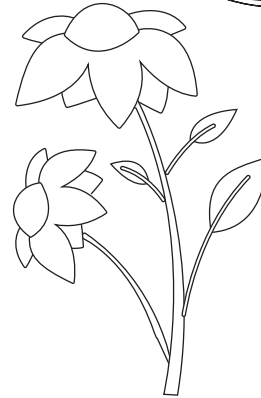
Marigolds



Alyssum



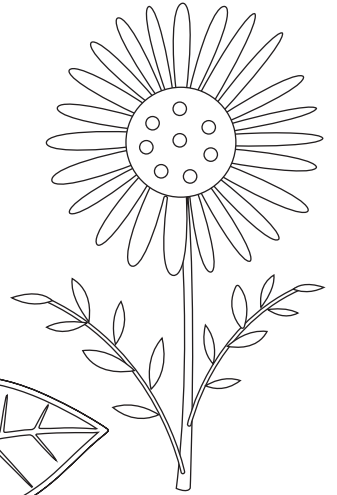
Tulip

Paper Cup Flowers

Create these cute, free-standing happy flowers using paper cups! These charming blooms are easy to assemble and add a cheerful touch to any space.

Skill Level: Beginner

Time to Make: 30 mins

Adult Supervision: Yes



What you will need

Paper cups - if you cannot find coloured ones then you can paint white ones with your favourite colours.

Safety scissors - make sure you have an adult to help.

Paints

Marker pen

Wiggle eyes - You could also use buttons or draw your own big eyes!



- 1 Take a coloured cup and mark a line roughly one inch from the base of the cup - this will become your flower head.

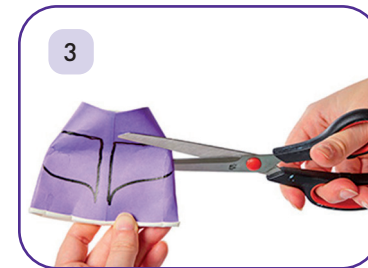
- 2 Now find the spine of the cup and draw a line either side of it stopping a few centimetres short of the bottom of the cup - this will become the stem.

- 3 Holding the cup with the stem facing you, squash the bottom of the cup flat and draw two symmetrical leaves either side of the stem. Make sure that they include the base of the cup.

- 4 Next, trim away the cup to leave the front part of the cup as the stem, and the double leaves at the bottom (so your flower is able to stand). The ring at the top will be made into the flower.

- 5 Cut slits around the flower head to make petals.

- 6 Add a happy face using the eyes and paints, or your coloured markers
